Project Harvest is a weeklong service program that gives you the opportunity to live together at Sprout Creek Farm while working at an organic garden, a CSA (Community Supported Agriculture), and a soup kitchen. You grow and harvest vegetables to feed others and yourselves. You explore new worlds, make new friends and gain broader perspectives. During your days here, you will come to a more empathic understanding of those in need. The world around you will change you. You will stand in awe at the interdependence of all living things.

Each day begins in the garden: planting, weeding and harvesting the fruits of your labor. From the garden, you will go to the “Lunch Box”, a soup kitchen where you will prepare and serve lunch to people in need. In the afternoon you will take some time alone to think reflectively and share your insights. You will refresh yourselves in Sprout Creek, do art, load hay, or build fences as you continue to extend your newly acquired skills. In the early evening you will milk cows and goats, feed sheep, bucks, heifers, collect eggs, and prepare the evening meal. As the sun descends on the gardens, the community gathers for dinner. This celebration rewards everyone

for her day of harvest. In the evening you can enjoy your friends, venture as far as our hay fields or deep inside yourself, read a book, play a game, or gaze at the stars.
